

How to Play – Shira’s Fetch & Match

Step 1: Cut the Cards:

Cut along the **outer dashed lines** to separate the cards. Then cut along the **dotted line under each toy** to make two cards: a **picture card** and a **word card**.

Game 1 – Shira Says: FETCH!

Spread the **picture cards** on the floor or table.

An adult or older child reads a word card and says:

“Shira says... Fetch the FOX!”

The child looks at the pictures and grabs the **correct toy card**.

If the child finds the correct card, celebrate!

“Great fetching!”

This game helps children practice:

- listening skills
- word recognition
- vocabulary

Game 2 – MATCH!

Place the **picture cards** face up.

Give the child the **word cards**.

The child reads or looks at the word and **matches it to the correct picture**.

Example:

FOX → fox toy

DUCK → duck toy

This game builds:

- early reading skills
- word recognition
- picture-word association



Game 3 – Memory Match (for older kids)

Mix all cards and place them **face down**.

Players take turns flipping **two cards**.

Try to match:

- picture + correct word

If they match, keep the pair!



Learning Tip

Start with **3-4 cards** for younger children.

As they improve, add **more cards** to increase the challenge.

Shira's Challenge!

Can you fetch the right toy when someone says:

- **FOX**
- **TRUCK**
- **DUCK**
- **PLANE**
- **BUNNY (Rabbit)**
- **SOCK**
- **CLOWN**
- **CAR**
- **SPIDER**
- **BEAR**
